SUMMER CAMPS FAQs

REGISTRATION:

1. WHAT IS THE COST OF CAMPS?

Full day camps range from \$129 to \$389 depending on the length of the camp. Please visit our [website](#) to see the cost of each camp.

2. WHEN IS CAMP TUITION DUE?

Camp tuition is due in full at time of checkout.

3. WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT DO YOU ACCEPT?

We accept payments by credit card through our online registration system.

4. DO YOU OFFER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE?

Outside the Lens offers a limited number of scholarships for families in need on a first come, first serve basis. We are able to provide scholarships with the support of our donors. To apply for a scholarship, fill out the application [here](#).

5. WHAT IS YOUR CANCELLATION POLICY?

Outside the Lens offers full refunds on summer camp purchases. However, there will be a \$25 cancellation fee. Refunds may take up to 3 - 5 business days to process.

PROGRAM:

1. WHEN CAN I DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP FOR CAMP?

Drop-off: Students can be dropped off at the start of camps at 9:30 AM.

*Note: Some camps begin at 9:00 AM.

Pick-up: Students can be picked up at the end of camps at 3:30 PM.

*Note: some camps end at 3:00 PM.

2. WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING TO CAMP?

Note: Please label all items with camper's name.



Required Items:

- Lunch and snacks (Campers will need to bring a lunch and snack everyday. Outside the Lens does not provide any food or drinks for purchase so please ensure your campers have adequate food and drinks each day.)
- Reusable water bottle
- Sunscreen (Please apply first layer of sunscreen before arriving to camp.)
- Comfortable footwear (Campers will participate in various walks to either photograph or film.)
- Any medications needed during camp such as an inhaler or Epipen.

Recommended Items:

- Backpack to store items
- Hat and sunglasses
- Camera (if child has their own)

3. DOES MY CHILD NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN CAMERA?

Cameras and any other needed equipment will be provided during the camp, but students will be sharing the equipment with other students. If your child has their own camera, we encourage them to bring it.

4. DO I NEED TO HAVE PHOTOGRAPHY EXPERIENCE?

Whether you are new at photography, digital media or filmmaking, or wanting to build on what you already know, our camps provide the structure and mentoring to take you to the next level.

5. DO YOU OFFER HALF DAY CAMPS?

At this time, we are only offering full day camps.

6. WHERE ARE CAMPS LOCATED?

7. WHERE IS OUTSIDE THE LENS LOCATED?

Outside the Lens is located in Liberty Station in Point Loma. Our address is 2750 Historic Decatur Road, Suite 103, Barracks 15. We are located between HotSpot Pottery and Comickaze.

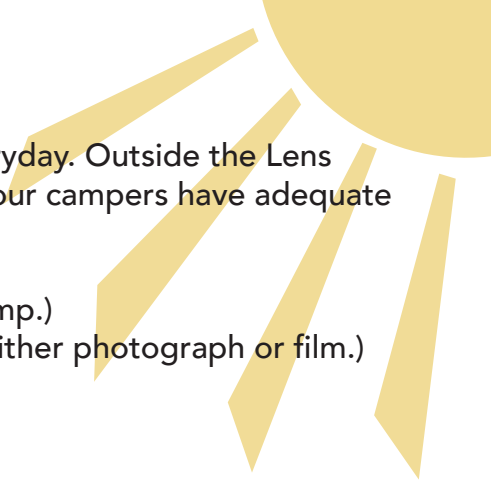
8. WHO TEACHES OUTSIDE THE LENS CAMPS?

Outside the Lens' Media Educators lead summer camp sessions. During the academic school year, our Media Educators teach throughout San Diego Unified School District, and other local school districts. All of our educators undergone background checks.

Our educators are creative professionals with portfolios in photography and filmmaking, and a passion for art, technology, and education. Their artistic styles and personalities are diverse, but they share a commitment to student success. Meet the staff [here](#).

9. WHAT IS THE CAMPER TO TEACHER RATIO?

We aim to maintain a 5:1 student to teacher ratio. Each camp has 1 to 2 OTL Media Educators who lead curriculum design and primary instruction. Educators are assisted by OTL summer interns and volunteers, who are high school and college students pursuing study in digital media. All of our



interns and volunteers attend an onboarding and training session. All campers will be under the supervision of our OTL staff at all times.

10. WHAT IS THE DROP OFF POLICY?

Please walk your child inside and sign them in each day of camp. Due to parking at certain locations, there are some camps where parents can drive up and drop off. In these cases, an Outside the Lens staff member will have the sign-in sheet available for you.

11. WHAT IS THE PICK UP POLICY?

All campers must be signed out by an adult authorized on the registration form for pick up. Only adults listed on the camp registration form will be allowed to pick up students. Older students will be able to sign themselves out at the end of the day if noted on the registration form.

12. WHAT IF I NEED TO PICK UP MY CHILDEARLY?

During camps, the groups take walks to photograph or film. If you are planning to pick up your child early, please notify the Camp Instructor at drop off in the morning. We will not be able to change camp plans to accommodate early pickups.

13. DO YOU OFFER EARLY DROP OFF OR LATE PICK?

Outside the Lens is offering after care until 4:00 PM (and until 3:30 PM for camps that end at 3:00 PM) for a flat rate fee of \$10 per day. Fill out the [following form](#) to sign up for after care.

We currently do not offer early drop off.

LOST AND FOUND

We do our best to prevent lost possessions, but to decrease the chances, please:

Label all belongings with camper's name and phone number

Only bring essential items and a backpack to carry them

Leave significant and sentimental items at home

ILLNESS/INJURY

If your camper becomes sick or injured at camp, an OTL camp instructor will contact you to pick them up. If we are unable to reach you in the event your camper needs medical attention, we will call medical personnel.
